No refunds will be issued after the closing date.

Proof of Archery GB Membership will be asked for when signing in. Only plastic membership cards, official eCards on a mobile or paper printouts from AGB will be accepted. Note: there is no facility to scan barcodes at the venue.

Target faces: 122cms and 80cm faces. 4 archers per target in 2 details, AB CD. The target list will be published on the day.

Dress regulations as per AGB rule 307.

This is a record status shoot and will be liable to drug testing. Competitors approached to give samples must comply; if they refuse, that refusal will be treated as a positive result. Written parental consent must be provided for JUNIORS if asked to comply.

Impairments: Archers with a physical impairment: Please inform the organiser if using a wheelchair, stool or perch, and whether you wish to remain on the shooting line or require a non-shooting target assistant to verify your end score and collect your arrows.

Shooting will be to Archery GB/World Archery rules. The judges' word is final. No intimidation of any kind towards officials or fellow competitors will be tolerated.

GDPR: When you enter this competition, the following information may be collected and shared with tournament organisers: Scoring systems and other competitors, for example, target lists and results may be published: First name, Surname, Gender, Bow style, Date of birth/Age category, Email address, Phone number, Club (and ID), County (and ID), Region (and ID), Round (unless defined by age), Disabled Y/N, Disability information supplied. **Your entry confirms permission for this data to be collected.**

Photography: Official or personal photography has to be authorised by the tournament organiser. If you plan to take photographs, please complete the sheet when signing in. **Competitors entry confirms authorisation for images to be taken.**

Venue directions. From the A66/M6 Penrith roundabout, continue east to next roundabout leaving at second exit onto Carleton Avenue. Turn right just before The Cross Keys PH, immediately turning first left towards the pub and follow the road **past the estate, down the hill.** Turn first left into the school lane. The school car park on the right. Shooting ground will be seen on the left.
